Gallaudet trustee-emeritus to be released from jail

John T.C. Yeh, who is currently designated as being a "trustee emeritus" of the Gallaudet Board of Trustees, will be released from jail in Maryland. Charges of theft are being dropped.

Yeh still has to appear in federal court on July 27 for sentencing after pleading guilty to defrauding the US government of millions in relation to video relay services.

Yeh served as trustee at Gallaudet during the Jordan administration. Jordan is a "president emeritus" of Gallaudet.

Follow-up, online note (Sept. 9, 2015): The Board of Trustees stripped John Yeh of his "trustee emeritus" status in 2012. John T.C. Yeh was sentenced to 9 years in federal prison in November 2011. See:
